



Apple Trees only available as container grown, not available as bare root.

Hat Trick Apple (aqua/blue/yellow paint)	Three apples on one tree. 'Honeycrisp' on the bottom, 'Sweet 16' in the middle and 'Zestar!' apples on the top. No pollinator required. (Zone 4)	Blooms:early-mid season. Ripens: late Aug/early Sept.
Macoun Dwarf (Aqua/red paint)	Medium-sized, dark purple-red fruit. Flesh is white, firm and very high quality. Crisp texture and well-balanced flavor. Good for eating. Fruit tends to drop when ripe. Good dessert apple.	Zone 4 Blooms: mid-season Ripens: mid-October
Royal Gala Dwarf (Blue/Pink paint)	Great early season apple with crisp firm fruit. Fine-grained texture and excellent flavor makes a sweet snack fresh or baked.	Zone 5 Bloom: early season Ripens: early August
Triple Play Apple – Early Season	Three early blooming apple trees in one container to form a clump. 'State Fair', 'Wealthy' and 'Zestar!'. All are good for eating and cooking. No pollinator required.	Zone 4 Blooms: early season Ripens: early-mid season
Triple Play Apple – Mid Season	Three mid-season blooming apple trees in one container to form a clump. 'Honeycrisp', 'Sweet 16' and 'Cortland'. All are good for eating and cooking. No pollinator required.	Zone 4 Blooms: mid season Ripens: mid/late Sept.
Triple Play Apple – Late Season	Three late season apples in one container to form a clump. 'Fireside', 'Haralred' and 'Honeygold'. All are good for cooking and eating. No pollinator required.	Zone 4 Blooms: late season Ripens: late Sept/early Oct.
Wodarz Apple (aqua/blue/red paint)	Has an uneven shape and yellow to green skin with a pink blush. Flesh is white, firm and sweet. Vigorous apple used for eating and cooking with good storage. Somewhat tolerant to fire blight. From North Dakota.	Zone 3 Blooms: mid-season Ripens: early October
